TRAVEL CHECKLIST

ESSENTIALS

- Sun protection and sun glasses
- Casual shoes, sandals
- Swimwear and cover-up
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Cell phone and charger
- Prescription medications (carry-on bag)
- Camera, battery, charger, memory card(s) (carry-on bag)
- Mini sewing kit (checked bag)
- Laundry bag and zip-lock bags
- First aid kit with aspirin
- Vitamins
- Toiletries and hygiene items
- Brimmed hat or cap
- Carry-on bag with change of clothes
- Foldable tote bag for tours/shops
- Sleepwear, undergarments, socks
- Exercise attire and sneakers

- Skirts, slacks, shorts
- Informal cocktail / dinner attire

- Tuxedo or dark suit

DRESS CODE

DAYTIME AND IN PORT

Casual, resort-style attire, including jeans and shorts, is welcome in all lounges and dining venues until 6pm. Swimsuits, brief shorts, cover-ups and exercise attire should be reserved for poolside, on deck or in the spa and fitness center.

EVENING ATTIRE AFTER 6PM WILL BE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

ELEGANT CASUAL

- **Men:** slacks with a collared dress shirt or sweater; Jacket optional
- **Ladies:** slacks /skirt, blouse, pant suit or dress.
- Jeans are welcome in all dining venues during the day
- Jeans are not appropriate in The Restaurant after 6pm

FORMAL

- In The Restaurant:
- **Men:** Tuxedo, suit or slacks and jacket required (Tie not required.)
- **Ladies:** evening gown or other formal apparel
- Dress in other dining venues is Elegant Casual
- Jeans are welcome in all dining venues during the day
- Jeans are not appropriate in The Restaurant after 6pm
